## AI Factories

- Dynamic innovation ecosystems, connecting **supercomputing centres**, universities, start-ups, industry and financial stakeholders
- Promoting AI adoption in **strategic sectors**
- **AI innovators** and selected EU-funded research projects will be **prioritised**
- **19 AI Factories** are being set up throughout the EU
- Investments: **EUR 10 billion** over the 2021-2027 period
- Next step: **gigafactories**

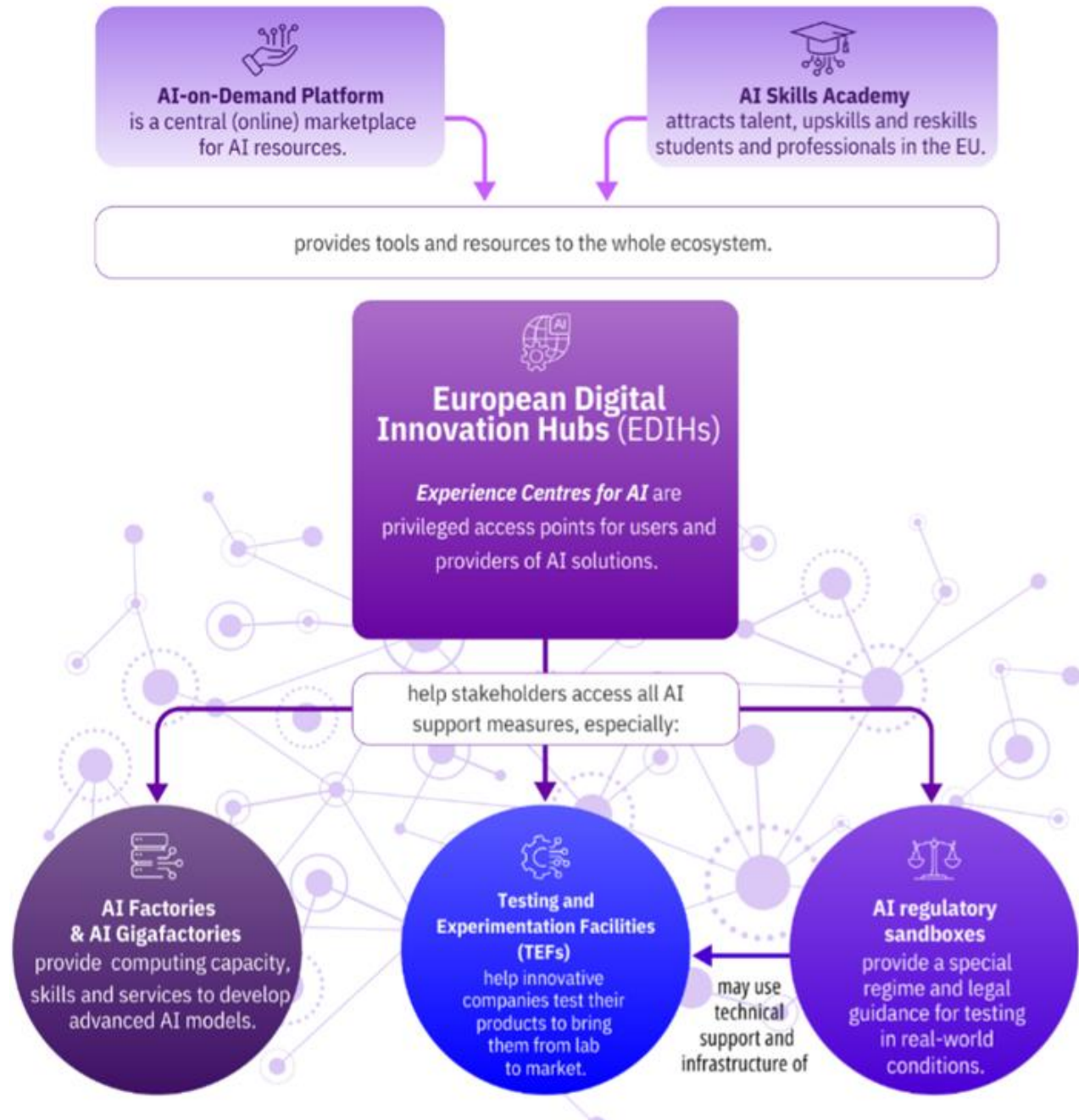
